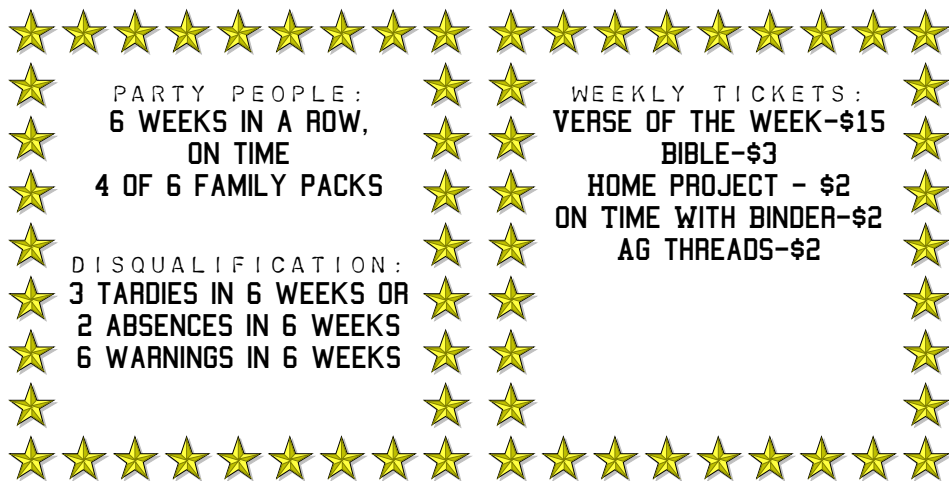

- **Please read the Peter and Herod story from Acts 12**  
*Read these questions, think about them, and answer them verbally first.*  
*Then, answer the questions in opposite order.*
- **What points stuck out to you?**
- **Why do you think God allowed Peter to be imprisoned if He was just going to get Peter out?**
- **Notice how surprised the people praying for Peter were that their prayers had been answered? Kinda funny, huh? Kinda scary though, too, huh? What are some things that you're praying for now that you would be surprised if you got them?**
- **Pray with faith for what you want, trusting that God will give you the good things that are good for you. We ask our earthly fathers for things, trusting that we'll get them if they're good for us...and it's good that we do, because if we didn't ask for them, we wouldn't get a lot of them. We're also thankful that He doesn't give us everything we ask for...Looking back, I'm glad my dad didn't give me all the candy I wanted (I wouldn't have any teeth now!). Likewise, we should be thankful that God is in control, but still ask, trusting in Him!**
